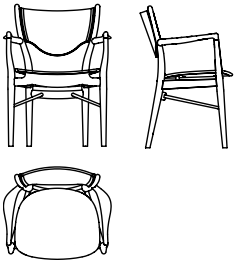

This chair is one of the most beautiful chairs from the hand of Finn Juhl, originally designed in 1946 for Snedkerlauget's exhibition for Niels Vodder. Later he modified the chair by making it more simple and beautiful for the then company Bovirke. This is the version that Onecollection now is re-launching. The chair can also be seen beside the working table in Finn Juhl's own house, which now has opened as a museum by Ordrupgaard Museum of Art in Charlottenlund, and also at the Museum of Art Louisiana, where the founder and manager Knud W. Jensen bought a number of chairs for the opening of the museum in 1958.

This chair is, like the 45-chair and the Chieftains chair, exposing some of the most outstanding within modern Danish furniture art, and will now be available for those interested in unique craftsmanlike quality.
